1. Three day intensive cleanse in Belgravia

2. Water therapy in a Cyprus spa

H20 is the new trend in spas. Now you don't just drink 118 litres a day, you do aqua yoga, swimming, paddle boarding, canoeing, waterskiing, hydro gym and so on; the list of watery fitness pursuits is ocean size. Easily the best place to whip your wet thighs into shape is Water Wellness in Anassa, Cyprus. You come back with glutes as toned as sharks'. 3. A medi-pedi in Marylebone village

If you want a complete sole overhaul, there's nothing better than hitting Margaret Dabbs for an MOT for the feet followed by a pro-pedi. (They use their own foot care range containing - wait for it - emu oil, and their glass file is particularly good.) You'll learn a lot about feet at 50 as you sit in the chair having yours knifed and filed. For starters, the cushion on the ball of the foot becomes thinner and moves towards the toes as we age - a bit like the rest of our body! The solution? Orthotics and lots of moisturising. 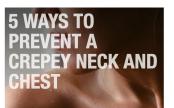
